The region covers the states of Acre, Amapá, Amazonas, Mato Grosso, Pará, Rondônia, Roraima, Tocantins and part of Maranhão

There are 5 million square km (3.3 million square km of forests). This represents 60% of the Brazilian territory












In 2009, Brazil recorded the lowest rate of deforestation in the Amazon over the last 20 years: 42% over 2008

In 2010, it is estimated that this rate will be even lower












COMMUNITY-BASED PROJECT: ILHA DO MARAJÓ (BELÉM DO PARÁ, BRAZIL)





- 1. Ecological Inn in Chico Mendes Extractive Reserve (200 km from Rio Branco);
- 2. Tourists can learn about the rubber cycle;
- 3. Families in an area of 24,000 hectares survive on sustainable forest management;
- 4. Production sold to cooperatives and marketed within and outside of Acre;
- 5. Conservation of the forest is an ally to social development, not a barrier;

Acre: US\$ 46 million in the consolidation of tourist routes, strengthening of local crafts and promotion of national and international events

Amazonas:
